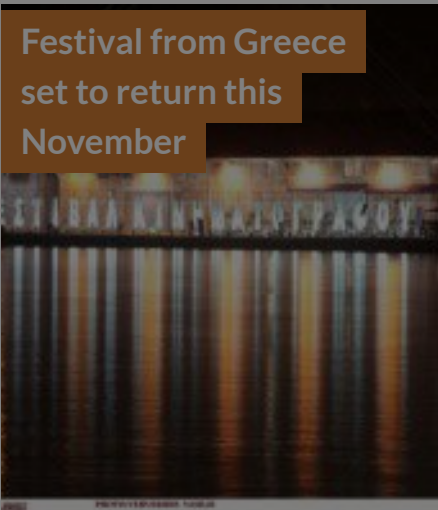
- Official international competition for first and second full-length feature films.
