The [Dutch Culture Center](#) (DCC), which was part of the Dutch presentation during Shanghai's 2010 World EXPO, won the International Award at the 2010-2011 Jing'an District Top Ten Cultural Activities Presentation.

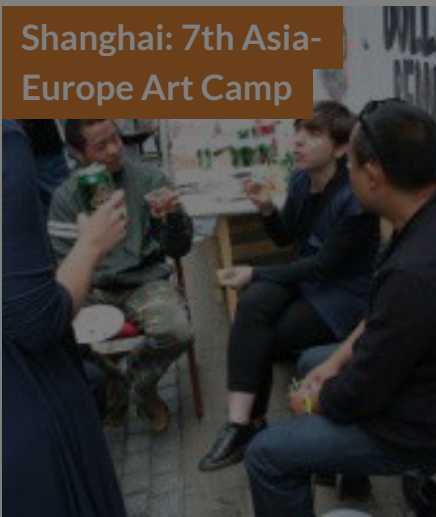

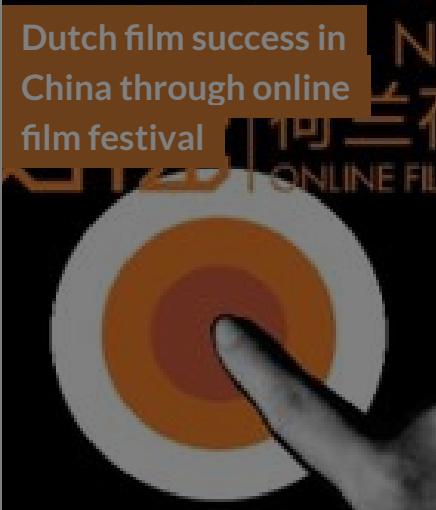

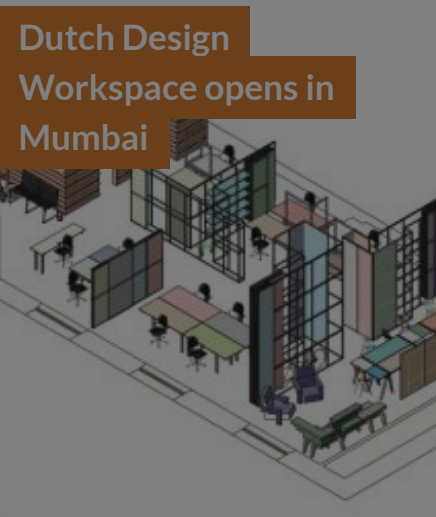
