BJDW has rapidly grown into the international leading platform dedicated to design in China. The 2013 Guest City is Amsterdam. The theme for 2013 is Design City - Smart City. The theme 'Design goes Dutch' is about the intersection where designers from the Netherlands, from China, and from around the world meet on equal footing and contribute jointly in formulating design solutions to the pressing issues of today and of tomorrow. As a present from Amsterdam, the globally beloved giant rubber duck, designed by Dutch artist Florentijn Hofman, will soon perk up in the Garden Expo Park and Summer Palace of Beijing. 


