The winner of the CPR Award 2010, worth 10.000 euros, was publicly announced on **7 October** at 14h00 during the **18th ENCATC Annual Conference** which took place in Brussels on 6-8 October 2010.

The **Cultural Policy Research Award** was launched in 2004 by the **European Cultural Foundation** (ECF) and the Riksbankens Jubileumsfond, and since 2008, is developed in partnership with the **European Network of Cultural Administration Training Centres** (ENCATC).

Designed to foster academic and applied cultural policy research and to explore issues at stake in contemporary Europe, the Cultural Policy Research Award aims to **contribute to new competence building among young scholars in comparative cultural policy research**.

The Winner of the 2010 CPRA is Claire Bullen, a 2nd year PhD Student at the Research Institute for Cosmopolitan Cultures – an inter-disciplinary research centre at the University of Manchester. The title of her research project is "European Capitals of Culture and everyday cultural diversity: Comparing social relations and cultural policies in Liverpool (UK) and Marseille (France)".
