Join [Visual Storytelling](#), a public forum featuring Magnum Foundation-supported photographers Chien-Chi Chang, Sim Chi Yin, and Lijie Zhang in Hong Kong on 16 December. They will discuss their work exploring social exclusion and economic disparity.

Sim Chi Yin will show [Dying to Breathe](#), a project that weaves together still photographs and audio to convey a gold miner's struggle with terminal lung disease. Lijie Zhang will share her project [CiCi](#), a photographic collaboration exploring albinism through layers of colorful fantasy. And Chien-Chi Chang will present [Side Chain](#), a video that revisits his previous work on mental illness.
