It is now up to you, the public, to cast your vote and decide who will be the winner of the “Public Vote”. The winner will receive a gift certificate valued at 200 euros.

Between now and **29 August** you can vote for your favourite photos by following these steps:

1. Login to Flickr.com
2. Go to the IIAS Photo Contest album (<http://tinyurl.com/IIASphotos>)
3. Browse through all the photos
4. Whenever you see a photo that you feel deserves a vote, click on the star at the bottom right-hand corner of the photo. This will place the photo on your “favourites” list







Only click once!!! If you click again you will undo your vote.
