

<u>India Today/Copenhagen Tomorrow</u> is a Danish/Indian project initiated by the Danish Holck-Larsen Foundation which aims to link the people of India and Denmark by promoting exchange of culture, science and trade between the two countries.

It is thus the aim that the various activities under <u>India Today/Copenhagen Tomorrow</u> will unlock Denmark and the Danes to modern India and allow Indians to become better informed about Denmark - to the mutual benefit of the people of both countries. The activities will strengthen the existing ties between India and Denmark and they will also strengthen the commercial connection and thus promote trade and investment between the two countries.

Each of the activities are individual activities under the institutions mentioned and most take place in Denmark. However, a common trait of all the activities is that they will promote the Indian/Danish relationship and be carried through under the name of India Today/Copenhagen Tomorrow.


