- **"Creating Contemporary Art Exhibitions"**, Whitechapel Gallery, London, 22-26 August

Registration for each of these courses can be done separately. Participants will gain exclusive access to world class collections, network with museum

and gallery directors and develop strategic plans for their institutions. Courses will offer an innovative mix of **seminars with leading UK museum professionals, creative workshops, hands-on sessions and 'behind the scenes' tours**. The International Museum Academy: UK 2016 will provide a **collaborative environment for sharing best practice and exploring common challenges**, as well as the opportunity to participate in a global network of alumni. Ongoing support will be given through **one-to-one mentorship**. The application period will open in late January 2016. 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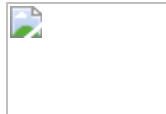
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
