ISEA2019, 25th International Symposium on Electronic Art will be held in Gwangju (Korea), from 22 to 28 June 2019 at Asia Culture Center (ACC).

For ISEA2019, under the theme Lux Aeterna, a topic inspired by a literal meaning of the host city Gwangju, "City of Light", it is planned to include subcategories embracing complex themes that allow open interpretations in culture, science, and history.
