

The M1 Singapore Fringe Festival 2014 marks the 10th year that The Necessary Stage (TNS) and M1 have been presenting the festival to the people! Check out the programme, which includes performances by theatre company Mundo Perfeito, from Portugal and Compagnie Kham / Olé Khamchanla in a France-Singapore dance collaboration. The Majurah Singapura – Tree Project by Hiroshi Sunairi from Japan involves Singaporean green fingers: Sunairi has distributed seeds of trees that survived the atomic bombing in Hiroshima, which are known as Hibaku trees, and has invited them to grow the seeds and nurture the seedlings. The exhibition will feature these seedlings along with the photographs and video interviews from former enactments of the Tree Project that have happened around the world.
