Project selected for Festival de Cannes 2017



MEMORY ! International Film Festival and **Myanmar Script Fund** are pleased to announce that **ONE SUMMER DAY**, Wera's first feature Myanmar film in development, is one of the 10 projects from around the world selected in [La Fabrique de Cinémas du Monde](#) at Festival de Cannes 2017.

Director Wera and Scriptwriter Aung Min, alongside producer Aiess Alonso (Green Age Film Production) were part of the shortlist candidates among the 9 projects selected for Myanmar Script Fund in November 2016, that took place within MEMORY Film Festival 4th edition in Yangon, Myanmar.

The project was also previously selected in Locarno Festival Open Doors Locarno Lab in August 2016. Myanmar Script Fund 1st edition took place in 2016 as a Competition and Education program within MEMORY International Film Festival in Yangon. Nine finalists candidates presented their film project in front of an international Jury chaired by Oscar-winner Director Michel Hazanavicius.
