



These guides provide a comprehensive and updated list of funding opportunities for the cultural mobility of artists and cultural practitioners in Asia and Europe, where cultural mobility is defined as "the temporary cross-border movement of artists and other cultural professionals."

The **Mobility Funding Guides** have been recognised by <u>UNESCO in its 2018 Global</u>

<u>Report</u> as a "comprehensive and updated list [...] for the cultural mobility of artists and cultural practitioners in Asia and Europe".
