

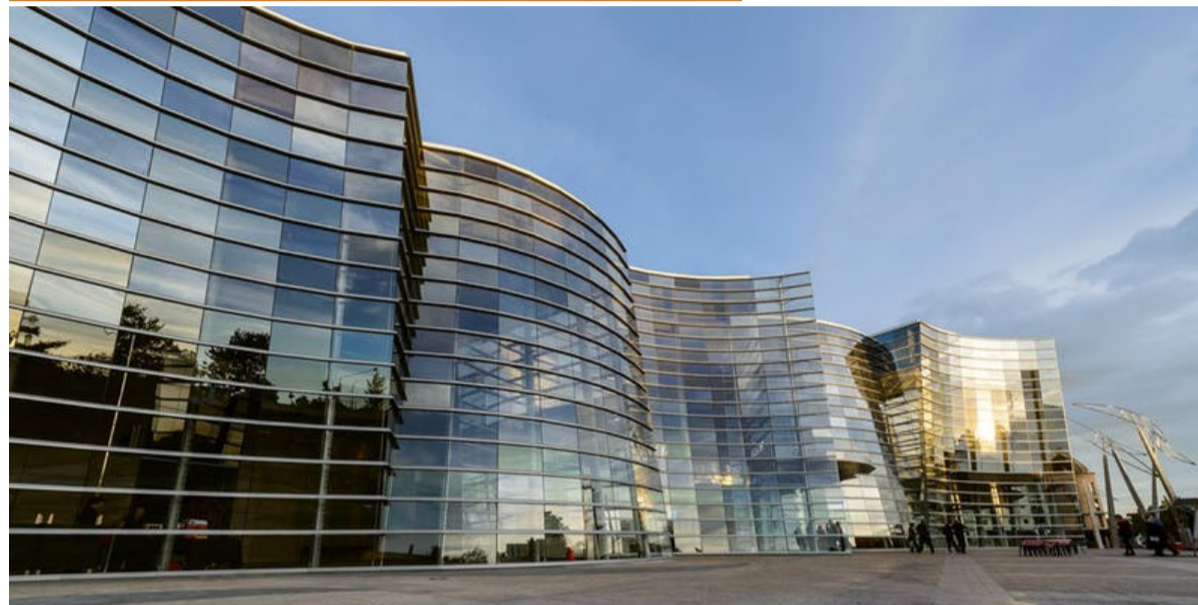

"Modern and Contemporary Materials: Research, Treatment, and Practice", the [2019 Annual Conference of the New Zealand Conservators of Cultural Materials Pu Manaaki Kahurangi Incorporated \(NZCCM\)](#) will be held at the Christchurch Art Gallery Te Puna o Waiwhetū, Christchurch, on 23-25 October. Over the first 2 days of the conference there will be a **range of speakers from across New Zealand, Australia, and beyond**, presenting on modern materials and techniques. They will cover a wide variety of specialisms and there certainly will be something for everyone. Day 3 will provide the opportunity to participate in a **several different conservation and heritage related activities in Christchurch** and the surrounding area.
