This online catalogue, in Chinese, provides information about the digitized audiovisual collections at the Archive, which cover traditional musical genres (including instrumental ensemble genres, solo traditions, operatic genres, and narrative singing genres), revolutionary music and pop music from the early 20th century to 1970s. 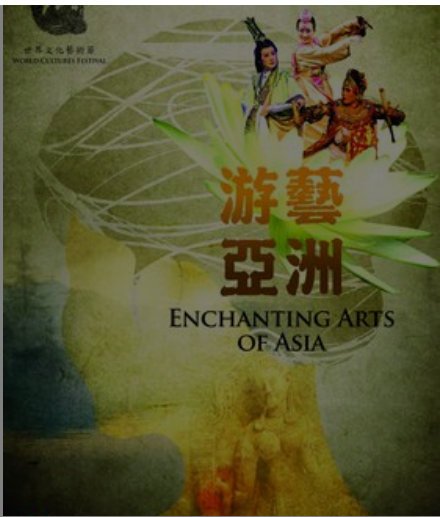

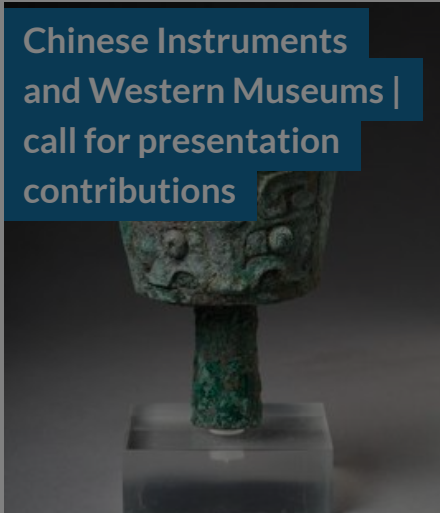
