 **royaldeluxeperth** The Perth International Arts Festival 2015 (13 Feb - 7 Mar) opens in an epic spectacle of wonder with Royal de Luxe's **The Incredible and Phenomenal Journey of the Giants to the Streets of Perth**, the biggest arts event Western Australia has ever seen. For three days over the opening weekend, the French masters of theatrical magic let loose a modern-day fable that will transform Perth forever, as 11-metre tall giants take inspiration from uniquely Western Australian stories and tour the city, commemorating the Anzac centenary. Perth International Arts Festival is the longest-running annual multi-arts celebration in the Southern Hemisphere and the jewel in the crown of Western Australia's cultural life. The programme includes performing arts (opera & dance, theatre & circus, music), visual arts, film and the well-regarded **Perth Writers Festival** (February 19-22).
