


The [National Museum of Contemporary Art, Korea](#) is launching a call for its international research programme dedicated to museum professionals including curators, art critics, conservators, exhibition designers, and educators. This programme is part of the [Cultural Partnership Initiative \(CPI\) Project](#) which is run by the Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism of Korea. Participants of this programme are mainly art museum curators from all over the world.

This research program aims to provide a sustained platform for initiating dialogues and for developing a comprehensive network among museum professionals, as well as furthering collaboration and joint programming among art museums internationally. The fellowship period is from 1 June to 30

November 2012.

- Individuals who work in related fields of contemporary art such as museum professionals, curators, art historians, exhibition organizers, conservators, educators, etc.
- Aged between 25 and 45.
- Countries from Asia, Africa, Middle East, Eastern Europe, and South America.

- Individuals who have high interest in cultural exchange.

The fellowship includes round-trip airfare, accommodation, monthly living expense of 900,000 Korean Won, Korean language course fee, and travelers' insurance fees.


