Celebrating its 10<sup>th</sup> edition in 2023, the ENCATC Award aims to stimulate **excellence in research in the field of cultural policy and cultural management** and create a network of competent scholars in this field. The Award has gained prominence over the last ten years, attracting submissions from across the globe and becoming a platform for sharing knowledge and expertise.

**Doctoral thesis submitted to the call should be related to the domain of cultural management and or policy** and must have been recently successfully defended (up to 2 years after completion of the thesis) by an emerging researcher from anywhere in Europe and the rest of the world.


An international jury will evaluate the applications and select the 3 finalists. The winner will be selected and announced at the occasion of the ENCATC Research Award Ceremony to be organised on **12 October 2023, in the framework of the 2023 ENCATC Congress in Helsinki.**
