2. AFIAS MOVING IMAGES AWARDS 2019. "EUROPE" section winner will receive:
 - One month International Artist-in-Residence Program in Madrid (Spain).

- Participants must be individuals aged eighteen (18) years or over at the time of the Submission(s).

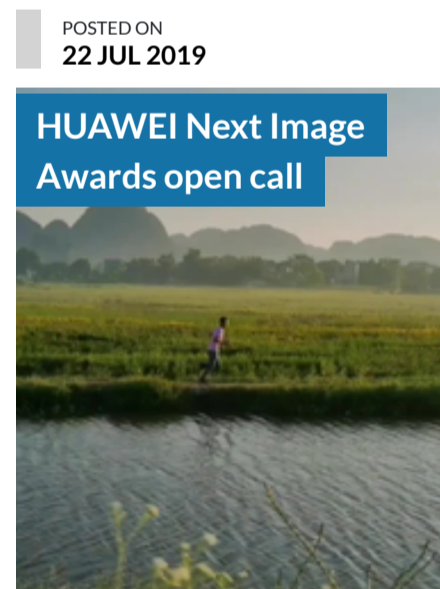
- The competition is open to every moving images professional.
