international presenters of Korean performances



Center Stage Korea (CSK), initiated and organized by Korea Arts Management Service (KAMS), is a partnership with international presenters. In cooperation with festivals, venues and networks, Center Stage Korea introduces Korea's diverse performances to audiences around the world, thus strengthening cultural enrichment, mutual understanding and exchange in the field of arts.

Who can apply

International presenters (in charge of a festival, venue or network) seeking to organize a program featuring Korean artists/groups

Eligible projects

- The proposed project must remunerate Korean artists/groups appropriately (e.g. performance

fees, accommodation and per diem).

- The proposed project must start and end between February 2019 and December 2020
- Projects that start in 2020 are to provide Korean artists/groups with financial support in 2020.

Covered cost by the grants:

- Part of the international airfare and freight cost of invited Korean performing artists/groups
- Amount of grant to be confirmed through screening
- Grants will go directly to the artists/groups.
- Joint plan to organize additional programs for the invited Korean artists/groups
- In case that the condition of invitation or the invited Korean groups is changed, grant support would be canceled and changed.

Center Stage Korea partners with presenters, performing arts centers, theatres, and others staging Korea-focused performing arts programs.

Eligible Projects

- A single festival or series presenting a Korea-focused program featuring multiple Korean performing artists/companies
- A tour engagement featuring one or more Korean performing artists' companies with one presenter (either independent or festival venue)
- The project must occur between March and December 2015.

Who Can Apply

- International producers/presenters of festivals, performing arts centers, and theatres

Required Documents

- Completed KSMF proposal application
- Additional documents as stated materials demonstrating previous projects

Grant Terms

- The Center Stage Korea Korea grant provides assistance with international travel.
