Finalist Announcement: 15 September 2015


Camp Date: 25-30 December 2015

Who can attend?

- CIAC is open for all art loving, cultural-minded people across the globe. It calls for artists in a broad sense from visual or conventional art media to the multidisciplinary periphery (poets, writers, journalists, singers or musicians, film makers and so on).
- Even though there is no age limitation to become a CIAC participant, young artists will be given priority.
- The CIAC is targeted to adventurous and enthusiastic persons who
 can accept challenges to comfortable living. People accustomed to
 luxurious suite and feasts are firmly discouraged to join the CIAC. The
 camp is held in a rural setting where the food, accommodation and
 day-to-day experience is enjoyed by sharing common resources with
 fellow artists and community people.


