The ENCATC European network on Cultural Management and Cultural Policy education has two research opportunities. Young cultural policy and management researchers may apply for the **Research Award**, all researchers can submit to a **call for abstracts** for 2015 annual conference.

### NOTE: two different deadlines!

1. The <u>ENCATC Research Award on Cultural Policy and Cultural Management</u> is aimed at young researchers and granted to a recently published PhD thesis exploring, through comparative and cross-cultural research.

This prestigious recognition aims to stimulate academic research in the field of cultural policy and cultural management with an emphasis on its applied implications. The ENCATC Award also has the ambition to contribute to the process of creating a network of scholars who are competent in doing

comparative research projects in cultural policy and cultural management.

The ENCATC Award is granted to a recently published PhD thesis exploring, through comparative and cross-cultural research, issues at stake and taking a step from evaluative (descriptive) to comparative applied research. In addition, the ENCATC Award is rewarded to a PhD thesis that can inform policymaking and benefit practitioners active in the broad field of culture.

The ENCATC Award targets emerging researchers in the field of cultural policy and cultural management up to 35 years of age from Europe and the rest of the world.

- Cultural policy and arts management
- Culture and local, regional and national development
- Cultural heritage management
- Cultural and creative industries
- Culture in external relations and cultural diplomacy
- Cultural networking

Research in the following subject areas is particularly welcome:

- Digital means for audience development
- Participatory governance of cultural heritage
- Cultural and creative sector: entrepreneurship and innovation
- Promotion of cultural diversity: cultural external relations
- Monitoring culture and creative interventions: urban futures and social engagement


