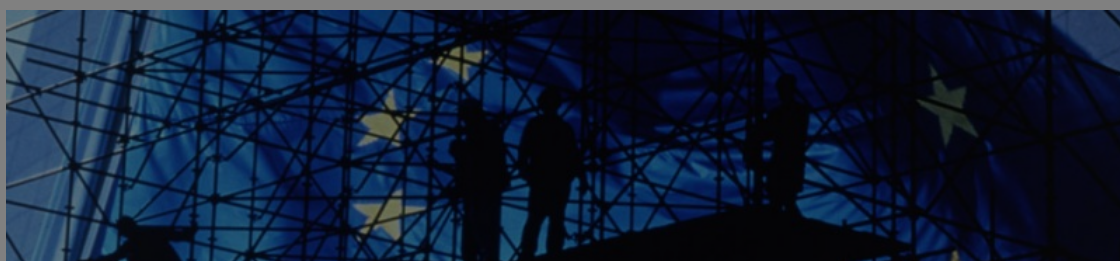
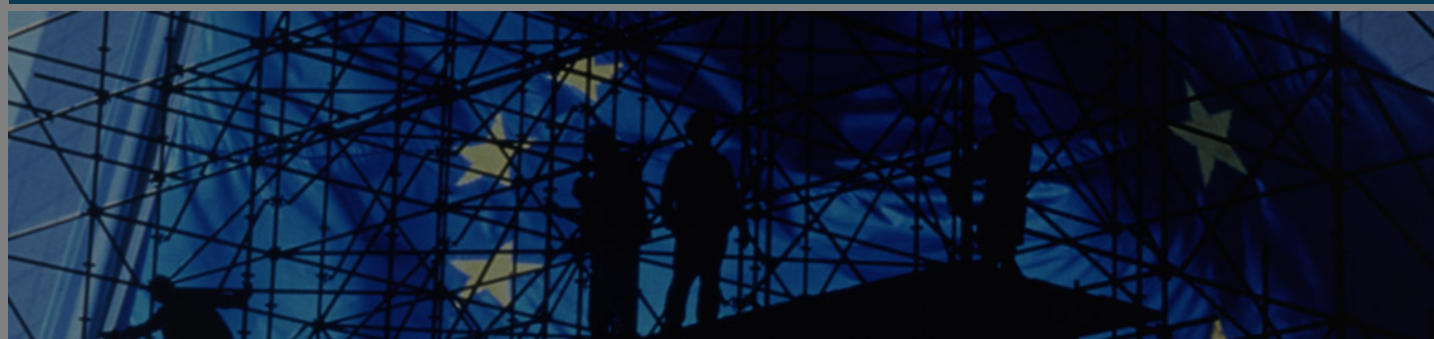

The European Union Centres in Australia and New Zealand are together convening an international conference: **Smart, Sustainable and Inclusive: Researching the EU from Australia and New Zealand**, to be held in September in Canberra, Australia. Call for papers on relevant topics.
