content and methodology, the **Global Cultural Leadership Programme (GCLP)** specifically aims to improve the skills of cultural managers, as well as develop collaborative peer-to-peer learning and network building. The programme offers a set of learning modules, tools and manuals for practice-based learning, giving you opportunities to build meaningful collaborations at the global level, and enabling you to develop fresh insights into international cultural collaboration practices.

For the second edition of the GCLP, the Cultural Diplomacy Platform is looking specifically for applications from outstanding cultural managers from the **ten Strategic Partners of the EU** (three participants from each of these ten countries: Brazil, Canada, China, Japan, India, Mexico, Russia, South Africa, South Korea and the USA), as well as from the **28 European Union Member States** (ten participants, each from a different EU countries).

come from different fields of relevant cultural practice in their respective

countries and represent sectors that are specifically interested in reaching out with their work globally.
