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# Biennale of Contemporary Keramics 2026 Rhodes Island, GR.

The Biennale of Contemporary Keramics (BCK) is calling for artists with a connection to a Mediterranean country to submit clay works, to be displayed at the Biennale from June to October 2026.

This edition of the Biennale of Contemporary Ceramics focuses on the **Mediterranean region**, celebrating its diverse cultures, histories, and contemporary artistic voices. All works submitted must be recent and conceptually aligned with the theme of the Biennale.

Each artist may submit one work or one series of works considered a single artistic creation. The primary material must be clay, although additional media are allowed.

# Eligibility

Eligible applicants include artists who are born in, based in, or have a meaningful connection to a Mediterranean country. This may include artists who have lived, studied, worked, or spent significant time in the region, or those with personal ties through family, heritage, or partnership.

## **Prizes**

- The Prize for the winning work is 5,000 EUR.
- The Prize for the works awarded with a Special Mention is 1,000 EUR.
- BCK will cover two days of accommodation during the exhibition's opening for all participating artists.
