

## korea Arts management service



The Ministry of Culture, Sports, and Tourism of Korea and

<u>Korea Arts Management Service</u> (KAMS) are inviting applications from Korean and international performing arts organizations, associations festivals and theatres for the development of original projects for international collaboration which should take place between **March 2011 and December 2012**.

The application has to be done by the Korean partner and the project has to be based on **long-term cooperation between specific international partners or those in the same field**. Organisations currently working with a Korean partner or who have one in mind for this project, can jointly work on the application.

Examples of Funding for International Collaborative Project include international collaborations on a new work or a workshop or a residency to strengthen the capability of performing arts specialists. KAMS provides support for sharing, development, and implementation of ideas by performing arts specialists, including producers, programmers, festival organizers, administrators. A maximum 40,000,000 won in project funding, indirect support like project administration and a debriefing session is supported by Kams.
