Description

Entries must be related to any of the following themes: humanitarian action, international cooperation

and social exclusion – human rights violations, armed conflicts, natural disasters, refugee and

immigrant populations, socially excluded groups, etc. – and/or efforts aimed at building a fairer, more egalitarian world.

FIRST PRIZE: a project grant of 6,000 euros

The winner will receive a project grant worth € 6,000 to develop a photo project related to the work of MÉDICOS DEL MUNDO, whether in Spain or another country, subject to the approval of the Organisation.

Requirements

- Only photos taken between January 2011 and October 2013 which have not been previously entered will be accepted.
- The photographs must be submitted in digital format.
- A maximum of ten photographs can be submitted, in black and white or colour.

Who can apply

The competition is open to adult amateur and professional photographers of any nationality.




