Music Cities Events is calling for application from professionals based in the EU for their online Music Cities European Exchange capacity building programme, 9 January to 20 February 2023.

The Music Cities European Exchange is a capacity building programme designed to create thriving music ecosystems. The **six-week virtual programme** includes live lectures, workshops and roundtables that will cover a range of topics including **introduction to music cities, music tourism, night-time economy, music and UN Sustainable Development Goals, socio-economic impact of music and music city policies.**

This EU-wide programme will also facilitate **cross-sectoral networking opportunities with a selection of 54 diverse candidates** across job functions from all the EU members states. The programme will also invite global leaders of music ecosystems to share best practices with the cohort.

Eligibility

- A working professional who is a resident in one of the 27 EU member states
- Able to communicate in English
- Working in one or more of the following: music industry, tourism, government, events and festivals, venues and NTE, sustainability, real estate, education, or in any other industry/role that is impacted by the development of music ecosystems
- At least two years of professional experience
- Demonstrated commitment to developing their city, town and/or place's music ecosystem
