

The Asia New Zealand Foundation is open for applications from New Zealand-based arts practitioners for their Arts Practitioners Fund. The Fund is intended to deepen artistic and professional connections with Asia, including through residencies, work placements, research tours and exchanges.

Eligibility

- Individual artists, including visual artists, writers, musicians, choreographers, directors and performers
- Individual arts managers, including curators, producers, programmers
- New Zealand citizens or residents who intend to live in New Zealand for one year after the completion of the project

The funding is for current practitioners who have a track record of professional achievement.

What expenses can be funded?

- Airfares
- Professional guides
- Accommodation
- Listing costs
- Ground transport
- Fees (residency, conference, market registration)

Applicants may request up to 7,500 NZD.
