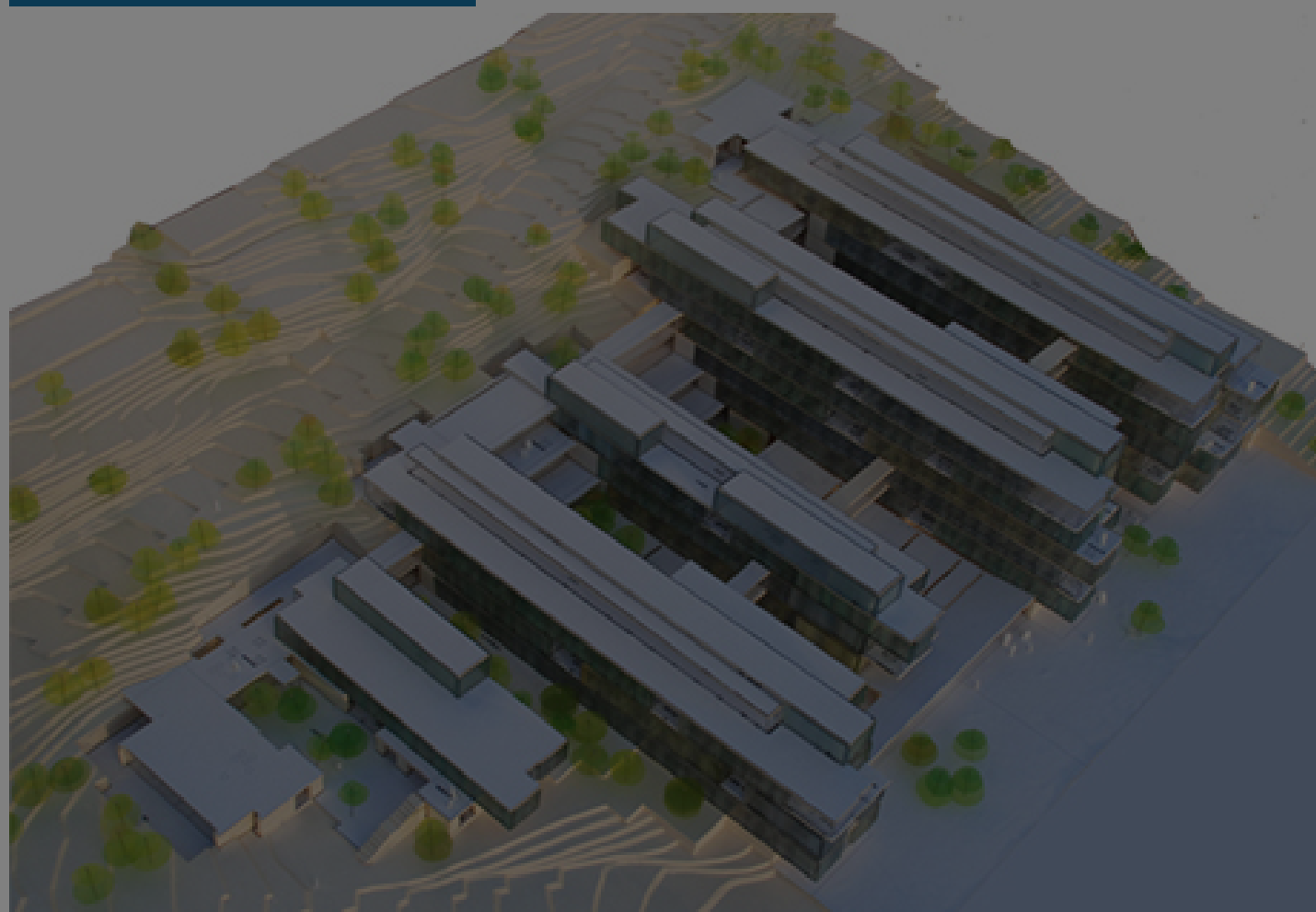

The purpose of the pre-qualification process is to identify candidates for two closed competitions.

Garden areas:

For the outdoor areas, we are seeking light-based artworks. The total project budget is NOK 3.5 million.

Entrance area:

For this area, we are particularly interested in interactive artworks in electronic media. The total project budget is NOK 1.75 million.
