The "National Art Exhibition" held annually at Bourdardorf, Schleswig-Holstein, Germany on June 1 and October 13, 2019, under the 3rd SPECIAL PROJECT MONGOLIA PAGE of Mongolia will be created.

The partnership which began with the 40th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between Mongolia and the Federal Republic of Germany is to commemorate the 5th anniversary of its cooperation with Mongolia in 2019 on the 45th anniversary of diplomatic relations between the two countries. Since its inception in Mongolia, Mongolia has been continuously participating in the framework of the cooperation of the Mongolian Academy of Arts and Arts, and has been steadily promoting the development of the Mongolian Fine Arts and the Mongolian Fine Arts. In 2015, Mongolia has over 120 artworks of 33 artists in the "Mainstream Transition-New Face" section of the "Mainstream Transition-New Face", in the 2nd Pavilion in Mongolia's "Tradition and Modernization" in 2016 over art, NordArt 2017, 1 artist, In addition, three artists from NordArt2018 attracted Mongolian attention and attracted over 100,000 European art-spectators and specialists each year.
