Pro Helvetia co-creation grants 2024



Pro Helvetia is calling for applications from artists or collectives for co-creation grants between the regions of the liaison offices and Switzerland.

Tandems who are active in any of the disciplines supported by Pro Helvetia, with **one part of the tandem based in Switzerland and the other in one of the regions of Pro Helvetia's liaison offices (including East Asia and South Asia)**, can apply.

Selection criteria

At least one member of the tandem has completed a research trip or a residency that was supported by Pro Helvetia (digital, live, hybrid). Alternatively, applicants may provide references of their previous collaborations in Switzerland and/or in a region of the liaison offices (at least two to three projects).

One member of the tandem has a Swiss passport or permanent residency in Switzerland, exhibits their work in nationally renowned, recognised institutions and can verify that they are active in national networks.

The application must be **co-developed by both tandem partners**.

Co-creation processes can be supported for a **maximum duration of 15 months**.

Support

A maximum grant of CHF 25,000 may include:

- Artists' fees
- Travel costs for both tandem participants
- Costs associated with the co-creation process and with planned activities including material costs, equipment hire, transport costs, etc.
