

Purin Pictures is calling for applications for their Activities Fund for film-related activities that promote Southeast Asia cinema.

Purin Pictures is a film fund that supports independent cinema in Southeast Asia. Started in 2017 under the Purin Foundation, they look for artists and organisations that are doing unique and essential work in a region that lacks adequate governmental support. Managed by Anocha Suwichakornpong and Aditya Assarat, their funding programmes cover film production, film post-production, and film-related activities.

The Activities Fund supports film-related activities (film screenings, workshops, festivals, etc.). The objective of the activity must be to promote Southeast Asia cinema, whether in the field of **exhibition**, **distribution**, **or education**. Unlike the production and post-production funds, the activity fund can be used for **activities held outside of the Southeast Asia region as long as the primary objective is met**.

The activity fund is a cash grant of up to 5,000 USD.


