Anyone aged 18-45 in the first 10 years of their creative practice
across the disciplines of advertising; animation; architecture;
computer game design; design; digital media; interdisciplinary arts;
fashion; film and video; literature and writing; music; the performing
arts; photography; publishing; television and radio production; video

You must be able to leave for the UK Before July 31, 2014

 Able to attend a two-day Awards and Finals on October 22 & 23 2013.

 In possession of a valid passport or able to obtain one by date of departure.

 Collectives can apply, but only one member will receive the prize value.
