

The report provides an overview of more than 40 key organisations, as well as profiles of the 14 cities that these institutions are found in: Beijing, Qingao, Luoyang, Wuhan, Shanghai, Hangzhou, Nanjing, Suzhou, Hefei, Guangshou, Shenzhen, Foshan, Changsha, and Chengdu.

During the Covid-19 pandemic, opportunities for international collaboration were severely limited globally. As China re-opens to the world, there are once again significant opportunities for cultural exchange.
