These principles are put into practice through **professional development opportunities**, accredited and non-accredited **training**, and tailored **workshops** with professional facilitators, building networks, support and mentoring.

They source input from our members face-toface, via surveys and call-outs, they also draw on their collective industry expertise and extensive national and international professional networks to identify and deliver relevant new opportunities and find better ways to do things.
