
The function of the Association is to enforce the common interests of the orchestras and

The Association is member of the Union of the Association of Employers and closely cooperates with the Ministry of Culture of the Czech Republic, the Association of Professional Theaters in the Czech Republic and the Association of Artistic Employers PEARLE (Performing Arts Employers Associations League Europe), based in Brussels.
