## Astrup Fearnley Museum



Astrup Fearnley Museet is a **private museum of contemporary art**, and has since its opening in 1993 been one of the most important art institutions in Oslo.

The museum moved to Tjuvholmen in 2012, located by the Oslo Fjord in a building designed by world-renowned architect Renzo Piano. The museum

presents temporary **exhibitions** of international art, and houses the **Astrup Fearnley Collection**, one of Norway's most important and most extensive private collections of contemporary art, with iconic works by artists such as Damien Hirst, Anselm Kiefer and Jeff Koons.


