In 2012, the European Commission's Directorate-General for Education and Culture (DG EAC) asked the EENC to map existing trends in cultural exchange between the EU and the Republic of Korea (South Korea) and their economic dimension. The request arose in the context of the implementation of the <a href="Protocol on Cultural Cooperation">Protocol on Cultural Cooperation</a>, which entered into force in 2011 as part of the <a href="EU-Korea Free">EU-Korea Free</a>
<a href="Trade Agreement">Trade Agreement</a>.

and South Korea in several specific fields, including publishing, performing arts, cultural heritage, the mobility of artists and culture professionals, cultural industries and audiovisual (with a particular focus on co-production), as well as the policies and cooperation frameworks existing in these fields. The report was completed in late 2012 but some tables were updated in September 2013, at the request of DG EAC.
