Fanglao Blackbox

Fanglao is the first collective experimenting, creating and transmitting dance at the crossroads of traditional and contemporary culture in Laos. Fanglao Black Box is a space for artists residency, creation, and diffusion of Lao traditional and contemporary arts forms. Since 2015, Fanglao Black Box is the space for regular trainings, workshops, performances. It is also a place to showcase and exchange dance practices through the organization of cultural events, festivals, projects and tours in Laos and abroad. Fanglao Blackbox is managed by Fanglao, a Vientiane-based dance company, founded in 2013 by the dancers Noutnapha SOYDALA (President) and Ounla PHAOUDOM (director) with the aim to develop artistic and choreographic practices in Laos.

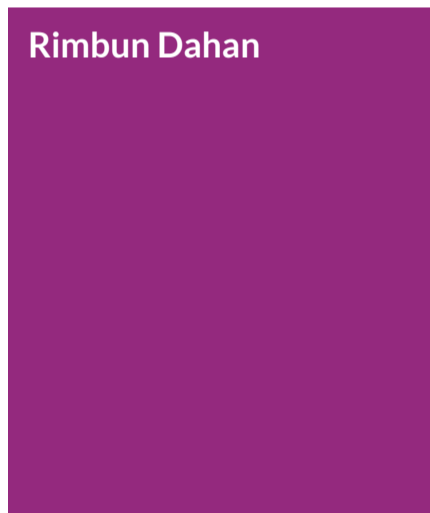

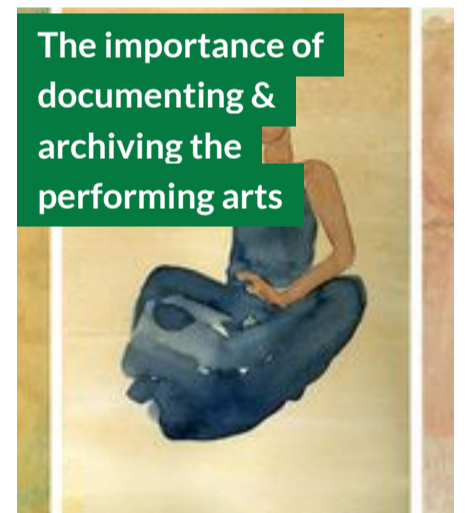

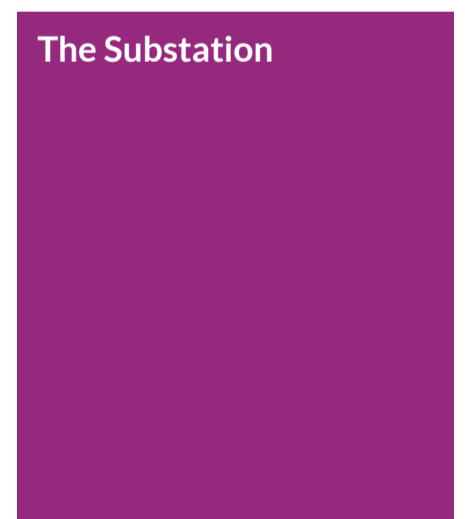
