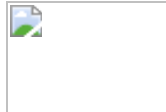
The Heritage Conservation Centre (HCC) is an institution of the **National Heritage Board** (NHB), Singapore. The HCC building, located in Jurong, is a **purpose-built facility for the storage and conservation of artefacts and artworks under the care of NHB.**

HCC also houses the centralised conservation laboratories for the treatment of object, painting and textile artefacts and a laboratory designed to cater for scientific analysis, material testing and research. By leveraging on their expertise in the areas of **conservation and collections management**, they hope to expand their role in the heritage community beyond Singapore into the region.
