The Institute has four sections: Radio, Television, Printed Media, and Administration. Seven teachers and trainers are working at the Institute. 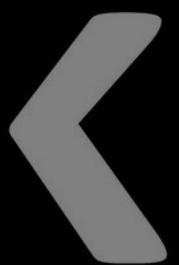
