With its concept “A film, a topic, a debate”, the FIFDH is an open forum to denounce human rights violations wherever they happen. Every evening, they invite **human rights activists, filmmakers and personalities** to debate, confront their points of view with the audience and offer solutions.

They have a number of competitive international sections and they have government support.

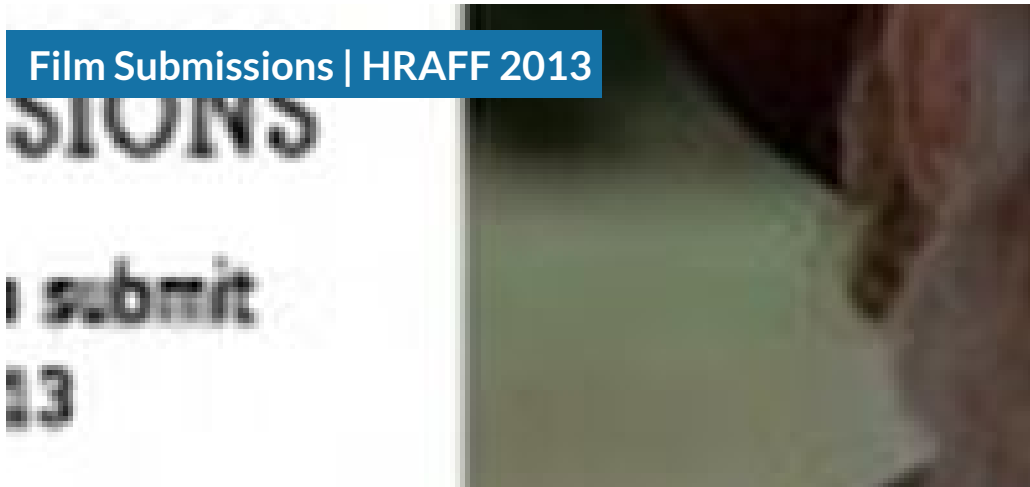
