
## The activities of MDC include the following:

- Collection and dissemination of data and information about museums
- Promotion of museum activities and their achievements in the community at large
- Promotion and development of museum related professions
- Dissemination of information concerning museums' related practices through the publication of professional journals and publications
- Promotion of professional standards and the development of the museum profession through

professional training and permanent education programmes

- Computerisation and the implementation of new technologies
- Promotion of the cooperation of Croatian museums with national and European heritage institutions
- Elaboration of proposals concerning museum laws and regulations
- Preservation of knowledge about the history of museums and galleries in Croatia


