The Museum, housed in the Ynchausti y Compañía building which was restored by the National Historical Commission of the Philippines in 2018, showcases **13 galleries**, including informative displays, artifacts, and interactive features detailing the **journey of the nation toward self-sustainability, innovation, and self-enterprise**.

- Silverware

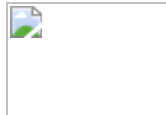
