NEMO **connects** European museums and their organisations to help to ensure their place in the cultural development of Europe. NEMO fosters European **policies** that help museums in fulfilling their role as keepers of cultural heritage by promoting their importance to European policy makers. NEMO **supports** European museums in their aim to learn from each other by networking and co-operation and shows them ways to participate in the existing European cultural policies in its function as an information channel between European institutions and museums.
