Government has become fully responsible for all administrative and organisational aspects of the Centre.

Thailand Cultural Centre, a division of the Office of the National Culture Commission, Ministry of Education, is an important institution which primarily deals with organising cultural services for the benefit of the general public. It is fully integrated **venue for social education and cultural activities**.


