C'A program fee:

The cost of the program is EUR 1150.

- production costs of the group exhibition
- accommodation costs will be partly compensated for each participant for a maximum amount of **EUR 500**
- travelling costs will be partly compensated for each participant for an amount of up to EUR 250
- local cell phone cards
