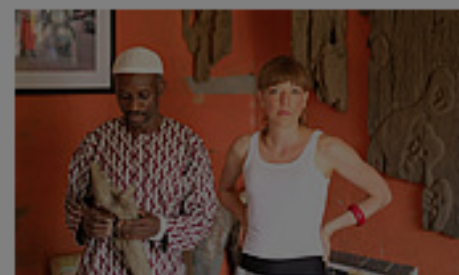

- travelling **from** developing and emerging countries **to** Germany (exhibitions, performances, artist-in-residence programmes, workshops, working tours, international events such as symposia, conferences and lectures).
- travelling **from** Germany **to** developing and emerging countries (performances, artist-in-residence programmes, workshops, working tours, international events such as symposia, conferences and lectures).

**Among the requirements (see website for full guidelines):**

- High standards of artistic quality


- The project may not be realized in a commercial context (e.g. not in a private gallery)
- Co-operation between German and foreign persons engaged in the cultural sector in terms of art and content is an important funding aspect


