

Trans Artists knowledge centre on artist-in-residence opportunities presents a special <u>Focus on Indonesia</u> with profiles of residencies and artists groups, interviews and Indonesian stories.

<u>Trans Artists</u> is based in the Netherlands and provides a wide range of information and up to date opportunities for artists residencies worldwide.


