

In January 2012 ENCATC launched the **ENCATC Online Journal of Cultural Management and Policy**, aiming to stimulate debate on cultural management and cultural policy among scholars, educators,

policy makers and cultural managers.

The Journal is based on a multidisciplinary perspective and aims to connect theory and practice in the realm of the cultural sector. The submitted papers regard different fields: culture and creativity, cultural management, cultural policies, marketing, local development, entrepreneurship, and education applied to the cultural sector. This new publication also aims to be a platform for multidisciplinary debate and new perspectives among researchers.

Issue 1 carries 7 articles selected by an international Advisory Board made up of 19 well established researchers and experts from 10 countries. 
